# WHAT A YEAR!

This year we have been able to hold all of our events and what a time we've had!



We've enjoyed a Harvest festival, our traditional Christmas bazaar, a new KS2 Christmas disco, a FIFA World Cup wall chart competition, an Easter Fayre, Mother's and Father's day workshops, two Rags to Riches collections, a fabulous Year 6 Leavers Disco and lots of tuck shop and ice cream Fridays.

All of our events and activities have meant that together we've raised an incredible **£8,636** this year! This is the largest fundraising total FoSPs have ever achieved (almost **£90** per pupil!) and that is testament to the fabulous support we have received from the St Peter's families, the school staff team and the wider community.
