It was a glorious afternoon when the children paraded around the village displaying their bonnets for all to see.

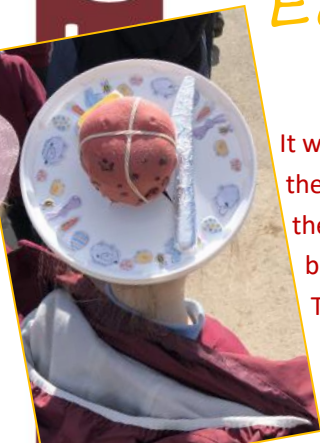
Thank you to everyone in the village who came out to see the children and to the FoSPs judges who

The Year 4s had a wonderful day rehearsing and performing to local care home residents at Christchurch Cathedral as part of the ODST music event.

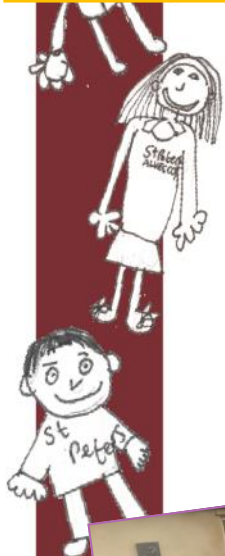


Farewell to St Peter's
