Exploring Milestones Museum

On Friday, Pegasus Class visited Milestones Museum in Basingstoke as part of our World War 2 topic 'A Child's War'. When we arrived, we spent some time in a public air raid shelter experiencing 'The Blitz' and also enjoyed a quick look around the museum. In the afternoon, we took part in workshops to learn about the role of an ARP warden during the war, which foods were rationed, how to identify enemy aircraft and had a look at an Anderson shelter. We also got to try on clothes from the 1940s and have a look at some 1940s rooms.

Before leaving, we visited Abraham's Sweet Shop, where we were able to use ration cards to collect a ration (2oz) of sweets to take home. We had a great time and are looking forward to using what we have learned in our topic work this term.
